Class Descriptions



Ready Set Dance

A highly interactive program designed specifically for Pre-School Children. Ready Set Dance Level 1 is suitable for 2 and 3 year olds and Ready Set Dance Level 2 is suitable for 4 and 5 year olds. (To be in level 2 students should be as a minimum attending 4 year old kinder). This is a fun filled class for our littlest dancers comprising of Jazz, Tap, Hip Hop, Music and Singing.

Ready Set Ballet

A perfect introduction to ballet with this specialised program for Pre-School Children. Ready Set Ballet is available as a 30 minute add on to Ready Set Dance. Please note that this class is not available as a stand alone class and can only be taken as a combo class with Ready Set Dance.

Primary Generation

A class designed for Prep and Grade 1 students which incorporates Ballet, Jazz and Tap in a single class. This class prepares dancers to enter exam/syllabus classes in Level 1 the following year. The main focus is building technique and confidence for students in the level between Ready Set Dance and Level 1 classes.

Elite Generation Extension Program

is available for both Junior and Senior Dancers. This program has been developed for dancers who are wanting to take their dancing to a higher level. The program is designed to allow students to condense classes into 2, 3 or 4 days with the full program covering a combination of jazz, ballet, technique & stretch, Technique Intensive, Acro, Contemporary and Hip Hop. Please Refer to the Elite Generation Extension Program documents for full details.

Jazz, Tap & Classical Ballet Classes

Open classes are non exam classes which allow students to learn each style without participating in exams. Level 1 and above boast a highly comprehensive syllabus that provides

dancers with correct training and technique in these disciplines. Dancers will have the option to enter exams through the Southern Federation of Dance. Whilst exams are optional, they are strongly encouraged as it builds self-confidence, improves technique and gives dancers a goal. In level 1, exams are very relaxed and teachers are allowed into the examination room with the students. Please note that students must be in Year 2 at school to commence in Level 1 and above classes.

Contemporary

Contemporary is a very unique style and allows dancers freedom of movement, but with control. A great class to compliment exam students! We have classes for ages 6-18 for beginner through to advanced senior students. Get ready to enjoy some turns, leaps, floor work and stretching. For safety reasons, knee pads are to be worn for all contemporary classes and are compulsory. Students must be in Level 1 or above to participate in Tinies Contemporary, aged 10-12 for Junior Contemporary and aged 13-18 for Senior Contemporary.

Hip Hop

A very popular style amongst dancers and a more relaxed style than jazz. Find your inner Hip Hop with our amazing classes! We have classes for ages 6-18, for beginner through to advanced senior students. Students must be in Level 1 or above to participate in Tinies Hip Hop, aged 10-12 for Junior Hip Hop and aged 13-18 for Senior Hip Hop.

Acrobatics

Classes are provided under the Canadian Designed Acro Dance Teachers Association (ADTA). Classes are designed to teach students how to safely execute tricks such as backbends, walkovers, handstands, cartwheels and incorporate them into dance routines. An excellent class to compliment each and every dancer to give them strength and flexibility. Classes are based on student age. Acrobatics classes are not available as a stand alone class Students MUST be undertaking a dance class to be eligible for an Acrobatics class.

Broadway Jazz/Musical Theatre

This class is for the student who loves to perform and let out their inner Broadway star! Focusing on performance quality, confidence and musical theatre based choreography, this is such a fun class for any level of dancer. This will incorporate choreography to Broadway/musical theatre songs as well as basic jazz technique.

Intensive Technique Classes

These are for the student who are striving to bring a strong, technical element into their dancing. This class will include stretching, turns, jumps, kicks, progressions and much much more. Students should have a good knowledge of dance before participating in this class. Aimed at the intermediate-advanced dancer.

Disneyland

Classes are for students participating in the 2022 Disneyland/USA trip.

Adult Classes

Designed for adults aged 18 and above and aimed at beginner/intermediate dancers. A fun and relaxed class where everyone has a great time! Different styles are incorporated into the class such as jazz, lyrical and contemporary, as well as strengthening and technique. A fantastic class for fitness.

Competition Solo and Troupe classes

Classes are by invitation only. Our Competition Troupes and Competition Solo students will have the opportunity to compete at different events and competitions throughout the year. A high level of dedication and commitment with established dance ability/technique is required to be a part of the Troupes. Competition Troupe is a great way for students to gain experience dancing in different environments, and to let them shine on stage as part of a team!

UNIFORM AND MISCELLANEOUS PAYMENTS

Payments for uniform, shoes and other miscellaneous items can be processed through the IntegraPay system (upon request), or can be paid by EFTPOS, Visa or Mastercard at the studio at the time of purchase.

American Express, Diners Club or Personal Cheques are not accepted at the studio.

ANNUAL CONCERT MEDIA FEE & COSTUME PAYMENTS

A link will be provided at the beginning of Term 2 with all payments due by the end of Term 2. The concert Media Fee is a compulsory charge per family participating in our Annual Concerts and entitles each participating family to a digital download of the Annual Concerts to share with family and friends..

EXAM FEE PAYMENTS

Exam payments are not included in your Term Fees. If it is deemed that your child is ready to undertake their exams in Ballet, Jazz and Tap you will be requested to make payments via a link provided at the appropriate time. Exam dates are subject to advice by Southern Federation of Dance and will be advised as soon as these are known.

COMPETITION ENTRY FEES

Solo and Troupe Media Fees and Entry Fees are not included in the class pricing. Parents will be advised for each competition how to make payments for any entry fees or other applicable charges imposed by the Competition Organisers.

DISCOUNTS

Class Discounts

Students enrolled in 3 - 5 classes will receive a 5% discount on fees (excluding Elite Generation Extension Program, jazz/tap/ballet packages, competition solo and troupe classes).

Students participating in 6 or more classes will receive a 10% discount on fees (excluding Elite Generation Extension Program, jazz/tap/ballet packages, competition solo and troupe classes).

Family Discounts

Families with more than one student enrolled will receive a 2.5% discount for all classes. (excluding Elite Generation Extension Program, jazz/tap/ballet packages, competition solo and troupe classes).

If Class Discounts have been applied to any Term Discounts, Family Discounts will also be applied.

TRIAL CLASSES

Trial classes for new students are offered in a 2 week block only. Pro-rata 2 weeks of fees must be paid prior to any trial classes. These fees are non refundable and if enrolment continues after the trial period, then the registration/enrolment fee will direct debited and any trial class fees paid deducted off the full term fees. Payment schedule will be advised for the remainder of any term fees upon confirmation of enrolment continuation.

INTEGRAPAY® DIRECT DEBIT TERM FEE PAYMENTS

Term Fees must be paid via the IntegraPay® Direct Debit Payment System. The IntegraPay® Authorisation Link will be emailed to you upon receipt of your enrolment and must be valid in order for your enrolment to be completed. If you already have an Integrapay® link activated, then your signed enrolment is authorisation to continue to charge to your nominated account. Fee payments are not accepted at the studio.

Terms and Conditions



By signing the enrolment form you are acknowledging that you have received, read, understand and accept all Terms and Conditions. Please read these carefully before signing your enrolment form and keep this page for future reference:

1. A non refundable registration/administration fee per student (as shown in Fees & Charges) is payable upon enrolment each year. The registration/administration fee is not a credit or payment against any Term fees.
2. A signed enrolment form for each student plus the registration/administration fee must be received for each new year of enrolment (or prior to the commencement of any dance classes for enrolments taken throughout the year).
3. All active Term 1 enrolments will automatically continue into each new term within each Calendar year and will be invoiced accordingly. If you do not wish to continue into a new term, written notification must be given by the end of the previous term. If notification is not received, then full current Term fees will be payable.
4. Once enrolled students must complete the term in the classes selected. Change of class can only be made at the commencement of Term 1 and Term 2 and only if vacancies exist. No change of class is possible after the end of Term 2 due to concert preparations.
5. Term fees are charged on a term basis. Once enrolled, full Term fees for all classes will be invoiced prior to the commencement of each term and a copy of the term invoice will be emailed to the email address provided on the enrolment form.
6. Payment for Term fees will only be accepted via the IntegraPay direct debit system. You can choose payments to be processed from your bank account or accepted Credit Cards (Mastercard, Visa, American Express).
7. Upon receipt of the Enrolment form you will be sent an IntegraPay direct debit authorisation/activation link by email. If you already have an active Integratapay account, then activation is not required again. The IntegraPay direct debit activation should be completed and submitted asap after receipt and within 3 business days, otherwise enrolment will be considered cancelled.
8. Term Fees will be processed in 4 x fortnightly payments through the IntegraPay® direct debit system commencing on the first day of each Term. If you are enrolled in the Elite Generation Program (a 12 month contract) then please refer to the Elite Generation Information Document for relevant payment options.
9. The following IntegraPay® charges will apply for each transaction
 - For each transaction from a nominated bank account - no additional charge
 - For each transaction from a Visa or Mastercard Credit Card 33 cents plus 1.87% of the transaction value
 - For each transaction from an American Express Credit Card 33 cents plus 3.50% of the transaction value
 - For each transaction rejected by your Financial Institution a Failed Transaction Fee of \$4.40 will apply
10. Term fees do not include payment for any uniform items, annual performance costumes, annual performance media fee, workshops, exam fees, competition costumes or competition entry and/or media fees.
11. No pro-rata fees or discounts to Term fees will be applied for any absences due to illness, family vacations, school commitments, other extra curricula activity commitments, religious holidays or withdrawal from a class at any time once the term commences. There are no make up classes provided for missed classes when a student is absent for any reason.
12. There will be no classes held on public holidays, school holidays, days where the heat policy is implemented or Concert Days unless advised otherwise. No pro-rata fees or discounts are applied for any days where classes are not held.
13. All discounts offered are as stipulated in the Fees and Charges document.
14. In order to participate in any Annual Concert performances, all fee payments must be current and up to date.
15. For purchase of uniform and other miscellaneous items items payments can be made at the studio by Cash, EFTPOS, Mastercard or Visa. Upon request these items can be processed by direct debit via your IntegraPay account with uniform collected after the payment has cleared.
